Prayer: The Primary Work of the Church

Please pray for three Alliance churches in northern Syria that are located in the "hot zone" of the Turkish invasion. Last weekend church leaders met to discern if they will lead their congregations to stay and serve, or to flee under threat of death. One has evacuated already, one is staying, and the other is waiting to see if the invasion goes further south. The evacuated church of 40 families will take up temporary housing in a monastery that has been graciously provided to them. Continue to pray for wisdom for the pastors and the Syrian Alliance president, Edward Awebdeh.

Also, pray for other churches and 100,000 Aran and Kurdish Christians in northern Syria who face voluntary or forced displacement in the face of the aggression and foreign occupation. May God give them supernatural strength and courage in midst of these dire circumstances.
