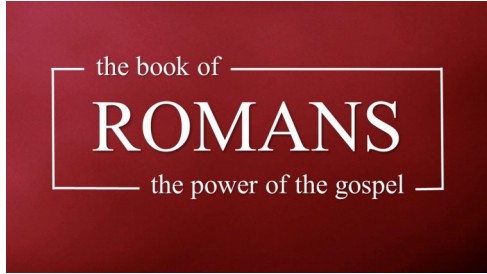


Welcome to CrossPoint Community Church
